Activity Name	Description
Assisting at Major School Events	This will help you to build up hours throughout the year by assisting in the organisation and running of various activities in the school.
Astronomy Club	This is a two year GCSE course where you can learn to understand and explore the universe.
Community Service	New Mills Volunteer Centre are always looking for support. You can register with them and help out.
Drama Club	Drama Club is held after school. You will support and assist the teacher in each session and work towards the final production.
Elderly Friends Christmas Party	Supporting with the organisation and the running of the party, collecting cans, sorting Christmas presents, designing invitations and helping on the day.
Form Rep	Represent your form at the school council and report matters back to your fellow students.

Grounds person	Work along side Craig at Peak Plants assisting with gardening and maintenance of the school grounds.
Journalist	You will be required to write up and photographically record events that happen within the Sixth Form for the school newsletter.
Library Assistant	To assist the Librarian with house-keeping duties, student behaviour and support Year 7 Accelerator Reading classes.
Literacy Ambassadors	To help incoming Year 7's with their reading on a 1-2-1 basis. Commitment and reliability is essential!
Music Enrichment	You may want to learn an instrument or are taking lessons already. You can join the school Band or Choir. To support and assist in the music clubs that run throughout the week.
Run a Football and Cricket Team	To support and assist Mr Taylor after school with managing a football team (Cricket team in Summer), you will be involved in training, fixtures and matches.

Teaching Assistant	To assist in lessons around the school, this may be with students who have learning difficulties or where an extra pair of hands could be useful.
Work Experience	Certain future courses require students to have a number of hours work experience. You must find your own placement that has the relevant H&S checks e.g. Nursery Nurse
Year 7 Classroom Assistant	To assist Year 7's in subject lessons of your choice, supporting them with their learning.

Compulsory to your choice, you will be required to attend a number of courses that the sixth form will run, including a 'Drivers Awareness' course run by the emergency services.
